Aboriginal people are thought to be one of the first to use stone tools to grind seeds, and the first to create ground edges on stone tools.

They could grind a precision edge from stone that was as sharp as any metal blade found in England in 1788.

Aboriginal stone tools were highly sophisticated in their range and uses.

Stone and natural glass were fashioned into chisels, saws, knifes, axes and spearheads.
