Food

Aboriginal men hunt animals to hunt they make spears or boomerang. The women were the food gatherers and they would go out and search seeds, vegetables, fruit and witchetty grubs.



Art

Aboriginal art is one of the oldest surviving art forms still practised today. The oldest paintings were painted thousands of years ago in caves. These would have been painted with Ochre.



Music

Music plays a major role in traditional aboriginal societies and is linked with a person's ancestry and country (the animals, plants and physical features of the landscape). It is traditionally connected with important event events such as the bringing of rain, healing, winding, enemies and the winning of battles.



Shelter

First people of Australia were nomadic people who came to Australia from the south-east Asia for you not know exactly when they arrive but it is at least 50,000 years ago.

Transport

Aboriginals walked because they didn't have fancy cars like us, sometimes then made canoes out of hollowed out logs.



Clothing

The Aboriginals wore animal skins and used them for making rijijs and usually paint their bodies.
