CLOTHES

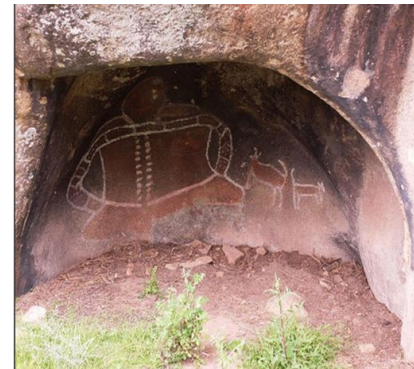


Aboriginal people

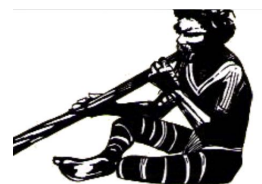
SHELTER
