As a child she grew up being extremely competitive but also a good sport, as she has an older brother.

Ash has an older brother called Ali, a younger sister called Sara, a mum called Josie, and a dad called Robert. Also, you might know, Ash is a major fan of dogs in fact, she has four called Rudy, Maxi, Affie, and Chino, that are mixed fluff balls. Ash was born on the 24th of April in 1997 in Ipswich, Queensland. Also, both her parents have a job. Her mum Josie is a Radiographer, and her dad Robert works at the State Library in Queensland, Australia. As a child Ash grew up in Spring Field. At an incredibly early age she was so talented she started to play tennis when she was four years old with her coach Jim Joyce. Then she fell in love with it. Ash had a good education unlike many other Indigenous Australians and made lots of achievements.

Evonne Goolagong is an Indigenous Australian and played lots tennis matches and was world number one at that time, but now she is retired.
