Art

Aboriginal art is one of the oldest arts that has surviving art forms. Paints were made from ochre mixed with Emu fats and kangaroo



oils. Ochre is stone

pigments. Traditional Aboriginal paintings always have a story because the Aboriginal people do not have a written language.

Transport

The main form of transport amongst traditional Indigenous people was walking. The Indigenous lifestyle was nomadic.

Food

Bush tucker, also called bush food, is any food native to Australia. That means the food is only found in the bush in Australia.



Clothing

The Aboriginal people would often use bark grass and leaves as clothing. In the cooler parts of Australia the Aboriginal people would wear clothing made out of possum skin.



Shelter

Most of Australia has a very hot temperature. Aboriginal people slept out in the open close to fires. Aboriginal housing mostly consisted of shelters made from branches, leaves and sheets of bark.
