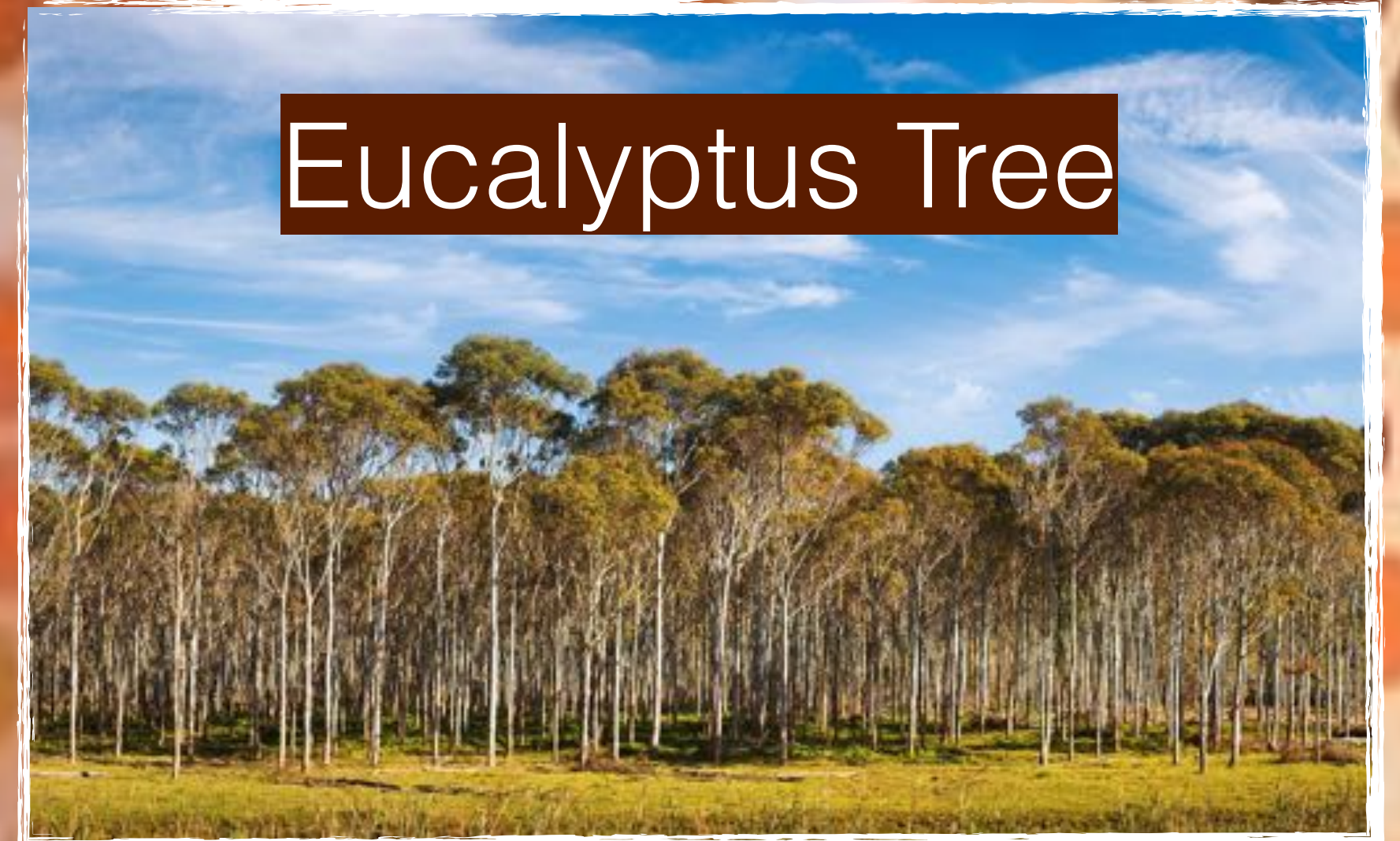
# What is a Didgeridoo?

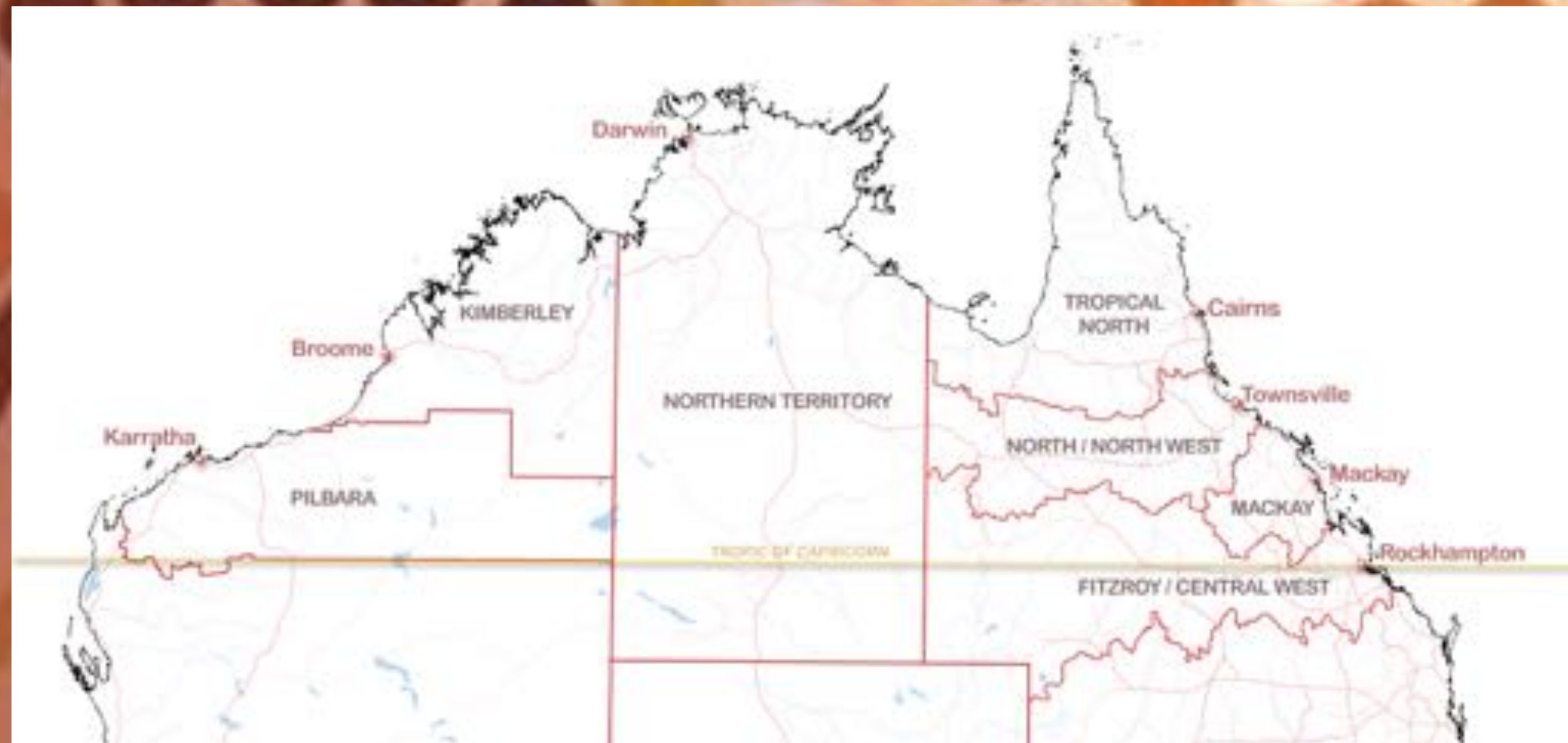
