
WHAT IS A CANOE?


WHAT IS A CANOE MADE FROM?

- A CANOE IS MADE FROM WOOD, THE ABORIGINALS GOT THE WOOD FROM TREES AND THEY USED SPECIAL TOOLS TO PULL THE WOOD/ BARK OF THE TREE AND THEN THEY SHAPE IT INTO THE SHAPE OF A CANOE.



HOW IS A CANOE MADE?

- A CANOE IS MADE FROM A TREE. THE ABORIGINALS USE THESE SPECIALS TOOLS AND THEY CUT THE WOOD OFF THE TREE AND THEN SHAPE IT TO THE SHAPE THAT YOU WANT IT TO BE.



WHAT IS A CANOE USED FOR?

Q CANOE IS USED FOR CATCHING FISH, A ROWING AROUND TO THE OTHER SIDE OF THE RIVER.

WHAT DO PEOPLE USE CANOES TODAY FOR THE SAME PURPOSE?

- FOR PEOPLE USE CANOES TODAY TO GO OUT INTO THE LAKE OR OCEAN TO CATCH CRABS OR OTHER STUFF. CANOE ARE HANDY NOW SO YOU DON'T HAVE TO BRING A BIG BOAT OUT.
