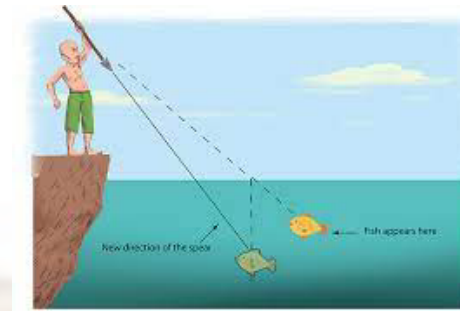

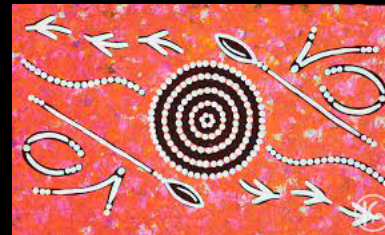
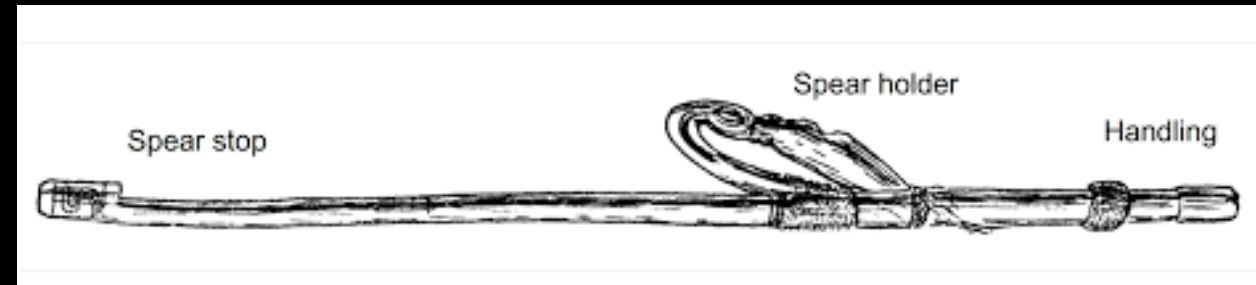

# What is A Spear?

- A spear is a sharp object that is used for catching food for Aboriginal people. The spear is supposed to be ditched at fish in the ocean. This is a very good object to protect yourself from animals that can try attack you. They also can have a blade on the end which is very sharp. They are a weapon for Aboriginal protection. A spear has been along for about 400,000 thousand years! It's like a javelin but a javelin is a light spear.





## What is a spear made from?

- A spear is mostly made of wood but the tip can be made of stone. Some people can have a wood one but they sharpen the end with rocks or more hard objects. The spears tip which is made of wood, metal or stone goes through a object because how sharp it is. The spear is hard and solid so it can not break and be destroyed unless it has not been looked after.



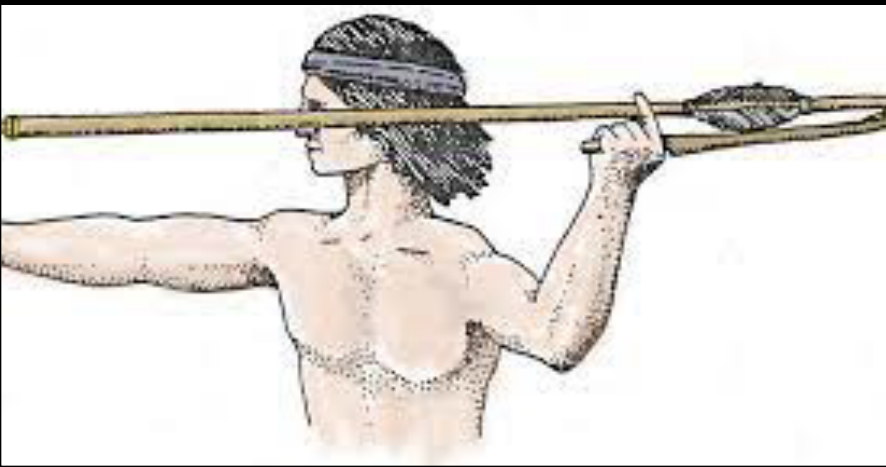


# How was it made?

- A spear was made once when a Aboriginal or a ancient person took a bit of wood and a stone and sharpened the wood on the stone then they turned it into a spear which then was used for catching prey. They sometime use bamboo and deep trees to make them. The deep trees make it harder to break so they can catch big food to eat.







## What was it used for?

- A spear was used to try catch prey and animals to eat for dinners ,breakfasts and lunch. Aboriginal people would always use their day to catch food to survive. There is different types of spears one of them is a holding spear and some of them have a holder to push the spear off from it.

# What do they use today instead?

- Today people will use spearguns and rubber spears they are not used for throwing they can shoot by itself like a gun. They are used for fish only, people do not use them on land. A spear gun is way more powerful then a normal spear. It reaches at fast speed and has a sharp metal tip that can go through solid objects.

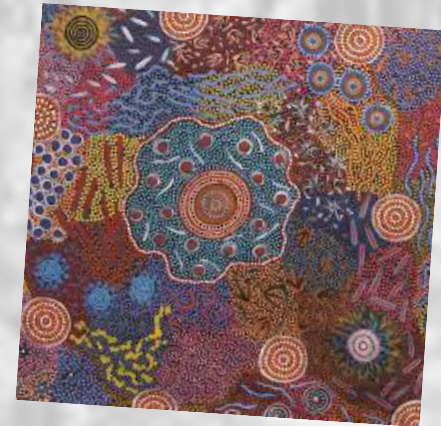
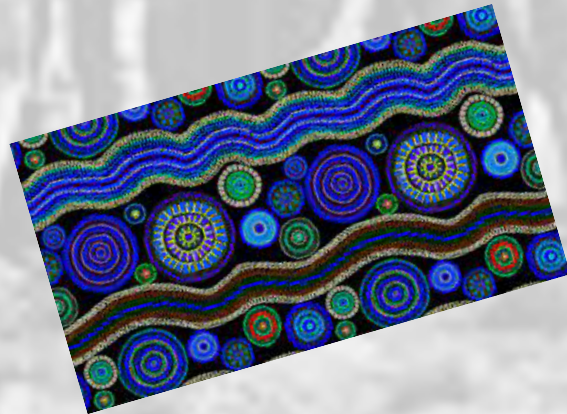




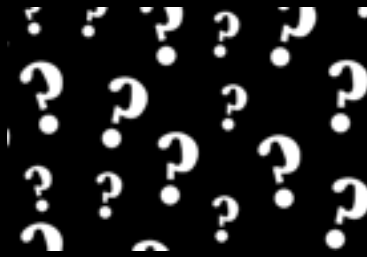
# Was a spear used in different Aboriginal groups?



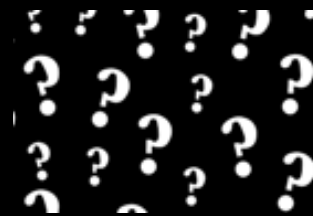

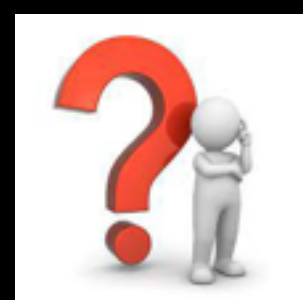
