FOOD

Aboriginals eat fish, kangaroo and fruit. Aboriginals go hunting for their food. Aboriginals use spears to hunt their food. Aboriginals also eat pig meat and lizards. They find food on trees and on bushes. They go fishing for fish and turtles to eat. They dig a hole and light a fire so they can cook their food. The Aboriginals put their food on a stick and they hold it near the fire.



ART

The Aboriginals use dirt and water to create paint. They also use mud as paint. The Aboriginals do dot painting, of animals like emus, frogs, dingos and fish. The Aboriginals do paintings on rocks to show their story's.



MUSIC

The Aboriginals like to play the didgeridoo and dance to the music. On the didgeridoo they play animal sounds. A didgeridoo is a type of musical



instrument, it is one of the oldest instruments to date. The
Aboriginals also play rain sticks.

SHELTER

The Aboriginals live in caves. They also build little houses out of sticks and wood. The Aboriginals build houses out of leaves. They also used bark off trees to build houses.



CLOTHING

The Aboriginals paint each other. The Aboriginals wear animal skin. The Aboriginals wear ducks, kangaroo and leaves. Aboriginals also wear grass.



Transport

Aboriginals make little canoes to get across the water. They also swim to get across the water. Aboriginals run and walk. Aboriginals do rope swinging to get to the other side of the lake. Aboriginals ride animals to get to their home.
